



## **At-Home Instruction (100% Cyber) “CAP CONNECTED”**

### **CONNECTED to CAP TEACHERS, STAFF, and COUNSELORS**

- CAP will begin the school year fully cyber until November when the situation will be reevaluated
- We are creating plans that will easily flow from at-home instruction to in-school instruction later in the school year
- All students will be placed into homerooms and rostered into classes as usual
- When your child can return to the classroom from at-home instruction, she/he will stay with the same teacher and class they have been with all year
- Curriculum content will come from your child’s classroom teacher; there may be some added support teachers to aid at-home instruction
- Your child will still have access to support from the CAP Counselors and Emotional Support Team

### **CONNECTED ONLINE: Devices and Internet**

- Each child from K-12 will be loaned a CAP device for remote learning
- Students in Grades 1-12 will be issued a CAP Chromebook
- K Students will be issued a CAP Tablet
- CAP has been reaching out to find out about families’ internet access and counselors are here to help you get connected, so your child can learn
- CAP will also be providing opportunities online and through in-person workshops to help parents navigate at-home instruction
- Your child’s teacher will reach out with more specifics on which programs they will be using, e.g. Google Classroom and, in some grades, ClassTag too. Here is an introductory video link of Google Classroom. <https://youtu.be/IgS-hoSljnw>
