### **CITATIONS**

#### ***1. QUOTING***

Whenever you take information word for word from another author, you must cite.

#### ***2. PARAPHRASING***

Paraphrasing is taking the ideas, research, or thoughts of someone else and putting them into your own words. **Paraphrasing needs to be cited.** If you are using the same source throughout the paragraph, cite ONCE at the end of the paragraph. There is no need to cite at the end of every single sentence, especially if it is coming from the same source.
